### INSTRUCTOR OF SPORTS & EXERCISE STUDIES

The School of Health and Behavioral Sciences at the University of Rio Grande/Rio Grande Community College invites applications for a full-time, non-tenure track position in Sports and Exercise Studies at the Instructor rank.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach courses among the following: introduction to sport and exercise, concepts in exercise science, essentials in strength and conditioning and human wellness and physical fitness. In addition, successful candidates will work to create hands-on learning and practical experiences for students; as well as, actively participate in program development and assessment. Instructors teach a minimum of thirty credit hours per academic year and are expected to advise students.

Minimum qualifications include a Master's degree in Exercise Science or a related field. Candidates with college teaching experience, interest and experience in strength and conditioning and/or holding a Ph.D. will be given preference.
